Office of state lands and investments.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to administration of government; providing
2 for the appointment and oversight of the director of the
3 office of state lands and investments and the appointment
4 and oversight of the state forester as specified; modifying
5 oversight of authority granted to the director and the
6 state forester; and providing for an effective date.

8 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9

10 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-2-2015(b), 36-2-108(a) and (b)(i)
11 and 36-3-101 are amended to read:

13 **9-2-2015. Office of state lands and investments;**
14 **director appointed; structure.**

15

16 (b) The administrative head of the office shall be a
17 director appointed by the ~~governor~~ board of land

1 commissioners with the advice and consent of the senate.
2 The director shall serve at the pleasure of the ~~governor~~
3 board and may be removed by the governor or by the board as
4 provided in W.S. ~~9-1-202~~ 9-1-202(b).

6 **36-2-108. Appointment of state forester;**
7 **qualifications; duties.**
8

9 (a) The ~~state board of land commissioners~~ director
10 shall appoint a state forester who shall be the
11 administrative head of the Wyoming state forestry division
12 of the office ~~of state lands and investments. He~~ and who
13 shall serve at the pleasure of the ~~board~~ director. ~~He~~ The
14 state forester shall have a bachelor's degree in forestry
15 with not less than four (4) years experience in
16 professional forestry work. The state forester shall, under
17 the general supervision of the ~~board~~ director, have
18 direction of all forest interest and all matters pertaining
19 to forestry within the jurisdiction of the state of
20 Wyoming; and may, with approval of the ~~board~~ director,
21 appoint ~~such~~ assistants and employees as are necessary in
22 executing the duties of his office.

24 (b) The state forester shall:

1

2 (i) Take ~~such~~ action ~~as may be~~ deemed necessary
3 by the ~~state board of land commissioners~~ director to
4 protect forest, range and other rural resources from fire.
5 This responsibility shall in no way diminish the
6 responsibility or authority of local fire protection
7 districts;

8

9 **36-3-101. Appointment; term; salary; removal.**

10

11 (a) There shall be a director of the office of state
12 lands and investments, who shall be appointed by the
13 ~~governor~~ board by and with the consent of the state senate.
14 The director's term of ~~his~~ office shall expire ~~at~~ as
15 provided by W.S. 28-12-103 after the end of the term of
16 office of the governor during which he was appointed,
17 unless sooner removed. He shall receive an annual salary as
18 provided by law, to be paid monthly by the state treasurer
19 on the warrant of the state auditor. The governor or the
20 board may remove the director as provided in W.S. ~~9-1-202~~
21 9-1-202 (b).

22

23 (b) Effective ~~July 1, 1979~~ January 3, 2007,
24 appointments and terms under this section shall be in

1 accordance with W.S. 28-12-101 through 28-12-103, except
2 that the board shall carry out the duties of the governor
3 under those provisions for purposes of this section.

4

5 **Section 2.** This act is effective January 1, 2007.
