6	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

8	Section 1. W.S. 18-3-107(f) is amended to read:
9	
10	18-3-107. Annual salaries of certain officers;
11	additional compensation prohibited; exception as to
12	traveling and other expenses; compensation of county
13	commissioner; appointment and salaries of deputies, clerks,
14	stenographers and other assistants.

1	(f) The state will pay <del>twenty thousand dollars</del>
2	(\$20,000.00) or fifty percent (50%) of the salary of the
3	full-time county and prosecuting attorney, whichever is
4	less, per year, to each qualifying county. In counties with
5	a population greater than nine thousand (9,000) the state
6	will pay fifteen thousand (\$15,000.00) or and fifty percent
7	(50%) of the salary of <del>a full-time <u>each</u> assistant to the</del>
8	county and prosecuting attorney, whichever is less, per
9	year, for each assistant <del>per ten thousand (10,000)</del>
10	population over nine thousand (9,000) to each qualifying
11	<u>county</u> . The state shall also pay <del>three thousand dollars</del>
12	(\$3,000.00) ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) for expenses
13	of the office of county and prosecuting attorney for each
14	full-time county and prosecuting attorney and each full-
15	time assistant authorized by this act. Payments under this
16	section shall be made annually on or before June 30.

**Section 2.** There is appropriated one million four hundred eighty-four thousand dollars (\$1,484,000.00) from the general fund to the county and prosecuting attorneys program to fund the state portion of salaries and expenses of county and prosecuting attorneys and assistant county and prosecuting attorneys as provided in this act.
