13 (a) The following are subject to forfeiture:

- 15 (i) All controlled substances, including
- 16 counterfeit drugs, which have been manufactured,

distributed, dispensed or acquired in violation of this 1 2 act; 3 4 (ii) All raw materials, products, and equipment 5 of any kind which are used, or intended for use, in manufacturing, compounding, processing, delivering, 6 7 importing, or exporting any controlled substances, including counterfeit drugs, in violation of this act; 8 9 10 (viii) Any property or other thing of pecuniary 11 value furnished in exchange for a controlled substance, 12 including a counterfeit drug, in violation of this act 13 including any proceeds, assets or other property of any kind traceable to the exchange and any money, securities or 14 other negotiable instruments used to facilitate a violation 15 16 of this act. Property used or furnished without the consent or knowledge of the owner is not forfeitable under this 17 18 section to the extent of his interest. 19 20 (e) When property is forfeited under this act, the 21 commissioner may: 22 (vi) Authorize any law enforcement officer to 23 apply to the district court with jurisdiction for an order 24

5 (f) Any controlled substance listed in Schedules I

6 through V, including a counterfeit drug, that is possessed,

7 transferred, sold or offered for sale in violation of this

8 act is contraband and shall be seized and summarily

9 forfeited to the state. Any controlled substance listed in

10 Schedules I through V which, including a counterfeit drug,

11 is seized or comes into possession of the state and the

12 owner is unknown, is contraband and shall be summarily

13 forfeited to the state.

Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2005.
