A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to water rights; amending the penalties for
- 2 violating water laws as specified; and providing for an
- 3 effective date.

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5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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7 **Section 1.** W.S. 41-3-616 is created to read:

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9 41-3-616. Penalties for violation of water laws.

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- 11 (a) Unless otherwise provided, any person violating
- 12 any of the provisions of W.S. 41-3-112, 41-3-208, 41-3-301,
- 13 41-3-318, 41-3-614, 41-3-914, 41-3-919, 41-3-937, 41-3-938,
- 14 41-4-501, 41-5-107, 41-5-108 or 41-5-110 is guilty of a
- 15 misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to exceed one thousand
- 16 two hundred fifty dollars (\$1,250.00). Each day of
- 17 noncompliance with the provisions of these sections shall

1 be deemed a separate violation. The possession, use or

- 2 presence upon any person's land of water lawfully denied by
- 3 the water commissioner or other competent authority is
- 4 prima facie evidence of guilt.

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- 6 (b) Failure to comply with an order issued by the
- 7 state engineer pursuant to W.S. 41-3-112, 41-3-208,
- 8 41-3-301, 41-3-318, 41-3-614, 41-3-914, 41-3-919, 41-3-937,
- 9 41-3-938, 41-4-501, 41-5-107, 41-5-108 or 41-5-110, shall
- 10 be a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to exceed one
- 11 thousand two hundred fifty dollars (\$1,250.00), or
- 12 imprisonment for not more than three (3) months, or both.
- 13 Each day of noncompliance with the order shall be deemed a
- 14 separate violation.

- 16 (c) Whenever, after notice and an opportunity to be
- 17 heard, the state engineer finds the holder of any permit is
- 18 willfully violating or has willfully violated any provision
- 19 of a permit or any provision of W.S. 41-3-112, 41-3-208,
- 20 41-3-301, 41-3-318, 41-3-614, 41-3-914, 41-3-919, 41-3-937,
- 21 41-3-938, 41-4-501, 41-5-107, 41-5-108 or 41-5-110, or of
- 22 any order issued pursuant thereto, the state engineer may
- 23 cancel or suspend the permit or impose conditions on the
- 24 future use thereof to prevent further violation. An appeal

- 1 from any decision of the state engineer may be made to the
- 2 board of control.

- 4 (d) Whenever, after notice and opportunity to be
- 5 heard, the board of control finds the holder of any
- 6 certificate of registration or certificate of appropriation
- 7 is willfully violating or has willfully violated any
- 8 provision of the certificate or any provisions of W.S.
- 9 41-3-112, 41-3-208, 41-3-301, 41-3-318, 41-3-614, 41-3-914,
- 10 41-3-919, 41-3-937, 41-3-938, 41-4-501, 41-5-107, 41-5-108
- 11 or 41-5-110, or of any order issued pursuant thereto, the
- 12 board of control may cancel or suspend the certificate or
- 13 impose conditions on the future use thereof to prevent
- 14 further violation. An appeal from any decision of the
- 15 board of control may be taken to the district court.

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- 17 **Section 2.** W.S. 41-3-112, 41-3-208, 41-3-301(a),
- 18 41-3-318, 41-3-613, 41-3-614, 41-3-914(b), 41-3-919,
- 19 41-3-937, 41-3-938, 41-4-501, 41-5-107, 41-5-108(b) and
- 20 41-5-110 are amended to read:

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- 22 41-3-112. Right to acquire temporary water rights for
- 23 highway or railroad roadbed construction or repair;

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24 wrongfully causing diversion to be shut down.

2 It shall be unlawful for any person who to wrongfully 3 causes to be shut down cause a diversion made under a 4 temporary water right required under and by virtue of this 5 act shall, upon conviction thereof, be guilty of a 6 misdemeanor and may be fined in an amount not to exceed one 7 hundred dollars (\$100.00) for each day for which he shall 8 cause such diversion to be wrongfully to be shut down. Any 9 violation of this section shall be punishable pursuant to 10 W.S. 41-3-616.

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12 41-3-208. Diverting from owner prohibited.

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It shall be unlawful for anyone not the owner thereof to 14 divert and take from the natural channel of any interstate 15 stream designated by the certificate required in W.S. 16 17 41-3-206 flowing within the state of Wyoming, any foreign water or in any manner interfere with the ability of the 18 owner of foreign water to transport the same in the natural 19 20 stream channel in Wyoming to the point of diversion and to 21 divert the same thereat. Any violation of this section 22 shall be punishable pursuant to W.S. 41-3-616.

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1 41-3-301. Application for reservoir construction

2 permit; contents; procedure.

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4 person, corporation, association, (a) Any 5 organization, of any nature whatsoever, hereafter intending to store or impound, for beneficial uses, any of the 6 7 unappropriated waters of the state of Wyoming, shall, before commencing construction of any works for 8 9 purpose, or performing any work in connection with said 10 proposed construction, make an application to the state 11 engineer, for a permit to construct a reservoir. The 12 application must set forth the name and post office address 13 of the applicant; the source of the water supply; the 14 nature of the proposed use; the location and description of the proposed work; the time within which it is proposed to 15 16 begin construction, and the time required for the 17 completion of construction. Maps and plans shall conform with the provisions of W.S. 41-4-510. In case of reservoirs 18 where the storage is for stock purposes only and the 19 20 capacity does not exceed twenty (20) acre-feet and the 21 height of dam does not exceed twenty (20) feet, the state 22 engineer may issue a permit without the filing of a map on tracing cloth; however the state engineer may require 23 24 certain information be submitted on special forms to be

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1 furnished by him. Any violation of subsection (a) of this 2 section shall be punishable pursuant to W.S. 41-3-616.

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4 41-3-318. Penalties, cancellation of permit, 5 failure to comply with W.S. 41-3-308 through 41-3-314.

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7 Failure to comply with the provisions of W.S. 41-3-308 through 41-3-314 shall subject the permit to cancellation 8 9 at any time pursuant to W.S. 41-3-616(c). Failure to comply 10 with any valid order issued by the state engineer pursuant 11 to W.S. 41-3-308 through 41-3-314, shall subject the permit holder to a penalty not to exceed five hundred dollars 12 13 (\$500.00) per day for each day the violation continues. The 14 state engineer is authorized to cancel any permit wherein 15 the provisions of the above sections have not been, or are 16 not being, complied with, and the cancellation shall 17 operate as a forfeiture of all rights acquired under and by virtue of any permit theretofore approved by the state 18 19 engineer. An appeal from any decision of the state engineer may be made to the board of control, and from the 20 21 decision of the board of control appeal may be taken to the 22 district court penalty pursuant to W.S. 41-3-616(b).

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1 41-3-613. Headgates, flumes or measuring devices;

2 owners to construct and maintain; failure to comply.

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4 The owner or owners of any ditch or canal shall maintain, 5 to the satisfaction of the division superintendent of the division in which the irrigation works are located, a 6 substantial headgate at the point where the water is 7 diverted, which shall be of such construction that it can 8 be locked and kept closed by the water commissioner; and 9 10 such owners shall construct and maintain, when required by 11 the division superintendent, flumes or other measuring devices at such points along such ditch as may be necessary 12 13 for the purpose of assisting the water commissioner in 14 determining the amount of water that is to be diverted into said ditch from the stream, or taken from it by the various 15 16 users. Any and every owner or manager of a reservoir, 17 located across or upon the bed of a natural stream, shall be required to construct and maintain, when required by the 18 19 division superintendent, a flume or measuring device of a 20 plan to be approved by the state engineer, below such 21 reservoir at a point not to exceed six hundred (600) feet 22 distant therefrom, and a flume or measuring device above such reservoir or each and every stream or source of supply 23 24 discharging into such reservoir, for the purpose of

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1 assisting the water commissioner or superintendent in 2 of determining the amount water to which prior 3 appropriators are entitled and thereafter diverting it for 4 such prior appropriators' use. When it may be necessary, 5 for the protection of other water users, the division superintendent has authority to require flumes to 6 7 installed along the line of any ditch. If any such owner or owners of irrigation works shall refuse or neglect to 8 9 construct and put in such headgates, flumes or measuring devices after ten (10) days notice to do so by division 10 11 superintendent, it shall be the duty of the water 12 commissioner of the district in which such headgate is 13 located, on order of the division superintendent, to close 14 such ditch to the passage of water, and the same shall not be opened or any water diverted from the source of supply, 15 16 under the penalties prescribed by law for the opening of 17 headgates lawfully closed W.S. 41-3-614, until the requirements of the division superintendent as to such 18 headgate, flumes or measuring device have been complied 19 with, and if any owner, or manager of a reservoir located 20 21 across the bed of a natural stream shall neglect or refuse 22 to put in such measuring device after ten (10) days notice 23 SO by the division superintendent, the water 24 commissioner shall open the sluice gate or outlet of such

reservoir and the same shall not be closed under penalties 1

2 of the law for changing or interfering with headgates

3 pursuant to W.S. 41-3-614, until the requirements of the

4 division superintendent as to such measuring devices are

5 complied with.

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41-3-614. Well, headgate or waterbox; prohibited 7 acts; penalty for violation.

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10 It shall be unlawful for any person who to willfully opens, closes, changes or interferes use or possess water which 11 12 has been lawfully denied by the water commissioner or other 13 competent authority or to open, close, change or interfere 14 with any well, pump, reservoir outlet valve, dam, 15 diversion, headgate or waterbox without authority., or who 16 willfully uses water which has been lawfully denied him by 17 the water commissioner or other competent authority, is quilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined not exceeding 18 five hundred dollars (\$500.00). The possession or use of 19 20 water lawfully denied by the water commissioner or other 21 competent authority is prima facie evidence of guilt Any 22 violation of this section shall be punishable pursuant to

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W.S. 41-3-616.

1 41-3-914. Adjudication of waters within control area.

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3 If any well owner, lessee or user within a (b) 4 control area refuses to adjudicate a well, or supply the 5 necessary information to permit adjudication of any well, the superintendent may tag and lock the pump or well to 6 prevent use of water therefrom. The penalty for interfering 7 with the tag or lock on a well is as provided in W.S. 8 9 41-3-938 41-3-616. The use of water from a well so tagged 10 and locked is prima facie evidence that the well owner,

lessee or user has violated the provisions of this section.

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13 41-3-919. Prohibited acts; penalty for violation.

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15 Any person who withdraws underground water or who fails to 16 stop or reduce the flow of underground water in violation 17 of any order of the state engineer made pursuant to this act, or any person who does not have a permit, certificate 18 19 or vested right to appropriate underground water who shall 20 withdraw underground water from any well other than a well 21 for stock or domestic purposes as defined in W.S. 41-3-907, 22 is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be 23 punished under W.S. 41-3-614-41-3-616.

1 41-3-937. Cancellation or suspension of permits or 2 certificates.

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4 Whenever, after notice to and opportunity to be heard, by 5 such holder, the state engineer finds that the holder of any permit is wilfully willfully violating or has wilfully 6 willfully violated any provision of such permit or any 7 provision of this act or of any order issued pursuant to 8 this act, the state engineer may cancel or suspend such 9 10 permit or impose conditions on the future use thereof to 11 prevent such violation, pursuant to W.S. 41-3-616(c). 12 Whenever, after notice to and opportunity to be heard by 13 such holder, the board of control finds that the holder of any certificate of registration or certificate of 14 appropriation is wilfully willfully violating or has 15 wilfully violated any provision of such 16 17 certificate or any provision of this act or of any order issued pursuant to this act, the board of control may 18 19 cancel or suspend such certificate or impose conditions on 20 the future use thereof to prevent such violation, pursuant 21 to W.S. 41-3-616(d).

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23 **41-3-938. Penalty.**

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1 Any person who drills, digs or constructs any works for the

2 securing of underground water without having obtained a

3 permit is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall

4 be punished under W.S. $\frac{41-3-614}{41-3-616}$.

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41-4-501. Permit required prior to construction of ditches, canals or other distributing works; contents of

8 application; unlawful diversion or use of water prohibited.

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Any person, association or corporation hereafter intending 10 to acquire the right to the beneficial use of the public 11 12 water of the state of Wyoming shall, before commencing the 13 construction, enlargement or extension of any ditch, canal or other distributing works, or performing any work in 14 said construction, or 15 connection with proposed 16 appropriation, make an application to the state engineer 17 for a permit to make such appropriation. Such application must set forth the name and post-office address of the 18 19 applicant, the source of the water supply, the nature of 20 the proposed use, the location and description of the 21 proposed ditch, canal or other work, the time within which 22 it is proposed to begin construction, the time required for completion of construction and the time required for the 23 24 complete application of the water to the proposed use. Any

1 person who shall wilfully willfully divert or use water to 2 the detriment of others without compliance with law shall 3 be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction 4 thereof, shall be fined in a sum not exceeding one hundred 5 dollars (\$100.00), or by imprisonment in the county jail for a term not exceeding six (6) months, or by both such 6 7 fine and imprisonment; and the possession or use of water, 8 except when a right of use is acquired in accordance with 9 law, shall be prima facie evidence of the guilt of the person using it punishable pursuant to W.S. 41-3-616. 10

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12 **41-5-107**. Removal or destruction of bridges or 13 flumes.

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15 Whenever any person, persons or corporation shall remove or 16 destroy any bridge or flume which crosses any ditch, canal 17 or other irrigation works, when said flume or bridge is in good condition a legal right for such crossing having been 18 acquired, said person, persons or corporations must replace 19 20 said bridge or flume, in as good condition as before 21 removal. If said bridge or flume is removed by the owner or 22 owners of the said ditch, canal or irrigation works; it shall be the duty of the water commissioner to keep the 23 controlling works of the said ditch, canal or irrigation 24

works closed until the said bridge or flume is properly 1 2 replaced. If It shall be unlawful for any other person or 3 persons shall to remove or destroy any such bridge or 4 flumes. they shall be deemed quilty of a misdemeanor and shall be subject to a fine of not more than one hundred 5 dollars (\$100.00) or imprisonment in the county jail for 6 7 not more than ninety (90) days, or both such fine and imprisonment Any violation of this section shall be 8 9 punishable pursuant to W.S. 41-3-616. 10 41-5-108. Driving or floating logs, timber or lumber 11 12 on streams. 13 (b) Anyone violating any of the provisions of this 14 section, shall, on conviction, be fined in any sum not 15 16 exceeding one hundred dollars (\$100.00), or imprisoned in 17 the county jail not exceeding three (3) months, or by both 18 such fine and imprisonment be subject to penalty pursuant 19 to W.S. 41-3-616. 20 21 41-5-110. Prohibited acts; penalty for violation. 22 23 It shall be unlawful for any person or persons who shall

knowingly and wilfully cut, dig or break down, or open any

gate, bank, embankment or side of any ditch, canal or 1 reservoir, flume, tunnel or feeder in which such person or 2 persons may be joint owners, or without authority, to 3 4 willfully interfere with or damage any dam, diversion 5 structure or means of conveyance whether jointly owned by the person, on the property or in the lawful possession of 6 7 another, or in the lawful possession of another or others, 8 and used for the purpose of irrigation, milling, 9 manufacturing, mining or domestic purposes, with intent 10 maliciously to injure any person, association or 11 corporation, or for his or her own gain, unlawfully, with the intention of stealing, taking or causing to run or pour 12 13 out of such canal or reservoir, feeder or flume, any water 14 for his or her own profit, benefit or advantage, to the 15 injury of any other person, association or corporation lawfully in entitled to the use of such water, 16 17 or of such ditch, canal, tunnel, feeder or flume, he, she, it or they, so offending shall be deemed guilty of a 18 misdemeanor, and on conviction thereof shall be fined in 19 20 any sum not exceeding one hundred dollars (\$100.00), and 21 may be imprisoned in the county jail not exceeding six (6) 22 months, or both, in the discretion of the court diversion structure or means of conveyance. Any violation of this 23 24 section shall be punishable pursuant to W.S. 41-3-616.
