In the second judicial district, one 4 (1) judge shall reside in Albany county and one (1) shall 5 reside in Carbon county. In the third judicial district two (2) judges shall reside in Sweetwater county. In the ninth 6 judicial district no more than one (1) judge shall reside 7 in Fremont county. All district judges in the state shall 8 9 have concurrent jurisdiction throughout the state and for 10 purposes of assignment, shall have concurrent jurisdiction 11 throughout the state with all circuit court judges.
