A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to unemployment compensation; authorizing  
2 the department of employment to reduce penalties on  
3 employers following cure of a delinquent account as  
4 specified; and providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 27-3-503 by creating a new subsection  
9 (j) is amended to read:

10

11 **27-3-503. Payment; base rate; failure to pay; rate**  
12 **variations; benefit ratio; new employer rate; special**  
13 **reserve rate.**

15 (j) Notwithstanding subsection (b) of this section,  
16 upon full satisfaction of an employer's delinquent account

1 and at the written request of the employer, the department  
2 may, for good cause shown, reduce by up to ninety percent  
3 (90%) the additional amounts payable as a result of the two  
4 percent (2%) delinquency rate.

6 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2005.
