- 15 this article. Any city, town or county may submit an
- 16 application to the council for a grant or loan under the

1 program on forms prescribed by and subject to rules promulgated by the council. Grants or loans may be applied 2 3 for by a joint powers board with the approval of all 4 participating agencies to the joint powers agreement. 5 Grants and loans may be made by the council for economic or educational development infrastructure projects, including 6 7 land, buildings, facilities, purchase of telecommunications infrastructure, rights of way, airports, 8 9 sewer and water projects, roads, landscaping, recreational convention facilities or other infrastructure 10 11 determined by the council to be consistent with the 12 purposes of this article. In adopting rules and making grants and loans under this article the council shall 13 14 require all projects to be related to economic or educational development infrastructure, which shall not 15 16 rehabilitation or expansion of existing include 17 infrastructure unless the applicant demonstrates council determines the rehabilitation or expansion is necessary to 18 retain an existing business or to facilitate the relocation 19 20 of a business to the locality of the applicant meet the 21 purposes of this article. All grants, loans or cooperative agreements made under this article shall be referred by the 22 council to the state loan and investment board for final 23 24 approval or disapproval.
