- 11 cities and towns benefited; exception for bonus payments.

- 13 (d) Any revenue received under subsection (a) of this
- 14 section in excess of two hundred million dollars
- 15 (\$200,000,000.00) shall be distributed as follows:

2	(iv) Two-thirds (2/3) <u>Fifty-six</u> and one-third
3	<pre>percent (56.33%) to the budget reserve account;-</pre>

5	(v) Eight and one-third percent (8.33%) to the
6	highway fund to be expended by the transportation
7	commission for engineering, constructing and maintaining
8	four-lane highways in this state as identified by the
9	department of transportation with priority given to roads
LO	and highways impacted by mineral development. Interest
L1	earned by the revenue deposited in the fund shall be
L2	retained in the fund and may be used for maintenance or
L3	four-lane state highways;

L 5	(vi) Two percent (2%) to the highway fund to be
L 6	expended by the transportation commission for maintenance
L 7	of state highways in this state. Interest earned by the
L 8	revenue deposited in the fund shall be retained in the
