A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the Wyoming Pharmacy Act; authorizing
2 pharmacists and pharmacist interns to prescribe and
3 administer immunizations; and providing for an effective
4 date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 33-24-156 is created to read:

9

10 **33-24-156. Immunization administration.**

11

12 (a) A pharmacist licensed under this act may
13 prescribe and administer immunizations to adults as
14 authorized by the board.

15

1 (b) The board shall adopt rules specifying
2 immunizations allowed under this act and the requirements a
3 pharmacist shall meet in order to prescribe and administer
4 immunizations.

6 **Section 2.** W.S. 33-24-130 is amended to read:

7

8 **33-24-130. Exemptions; administration of drugs and**
9 **medicine.**

10

11 Unless otherwise provided by law, the provisions of this
12 act do not apply to administration of drugs and medicines,
13 or to persons engaged in the administration of drugs and
14 medicines. Administration of drugs and medicines, for the
15 purpose of this exclusion, is hereby defined as actual,
16 personal distribution to, or injection in, or application
17 to a particular human being, of substances or material
18 which has already been prepared, selected, measured,
19 packaged, and labeled, or otherwise specifically identified
20 by a person qualified to do so under the terms of this act.

21

22 **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2005.
