- 15 (iv) Has provided written evidence that he has
- 16 completed at least one (1) year of postgraduate training in
- 17 an A.C.G.M.E., A.O.A. or R.C.P.S.C. accredited program. An

1 applicant who graduated from a medical school not

2 accredited by the L.C.M.E. or A.O.A. shall present written

3 evidence that he has completed at least two (2) years of

4 medical education at the medical school from which he

5 graduated and that he has completed at least three (3) two

6 (2) years of postgraduate training in an A.C.G.M.E., A.O.A.

7 or R.C.P.S.C. accredited program;

9 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon
