- 8 **Section 1.** W.S. 33-24-102(a) and 33-24-103 are

33-24-102. State board of pharmacy; generally.

- 13 (a) There is created a state board of pharmacy whose
- 14 duty is to carry out the purposes and to enforce the
- 15 provisions of this act. The board shall consist of $\frac{\text{three}}{\text{consist}}$
- 16 (3)—five (5) voting members consisting of four (4) licensed

1 pharmacists and one (1) licensed pharmacy technician and 2 three (3) ex officio members, who shall be appointed by the

3 governor, by and with the advice and consent of the senate.

4 Members of the now existing board of pharmacy shall

5 continue in office as voting members as if regularly

appointed under this act. Their terms shall expire in 6

7 accordance with their original appointments and be filled

in accordance with the provisions of W.S. 28-12-101. The 8

9 three (3) ex officio members shall be respectively: a

10 licensed practicing physician, a licensed practicing

11 dentist and a licensed practicing doctor of veterinary

12 medicine, who have had at least five (5) years of active

13 private practice in the state before their appointment. The

ex officio members shall have no vote and shall have no 14

part of licensing procedures or license suspension or 15

revocation actions. The ex officio members shall correlate 16

17 the interprofessional relationships in the uses, proposed

uses and distribution of drugs insofar as the three (3) 18

professions represented have direct interest. 19

1 (a) No person pharmacist shall be eligible to be a 2 voting member of the board of pharmacy who has not been 3 legally qualified to practice, and who has not been engaged 4 in the active practice of pharmacy in the state for at 5 least five (5) continuous years immediately prior to membership, who does not at the time of his appointment 6 7 hold a certificate license entitling him to practice pharmacy in the state, who is not a citizen of the United 8 9 States and a resident of Wyoming, and who does not actively practice pharmacy in Wyoming throughout his term. No 10 11 pharmacist member shall be appointed to, or serve, more 12 than two (2) successive terms. No member shall be connected 13 with a school or college of pharmacy in a professional or 14 executive capacity.

(b) No pharmacy technician shall be eligible to be a voting member of the board of pharmacy who has not been legally qualified in assisting pharmacists in the practice of pharmacy, and who has not been engaged in active practice as a pharmacy technician in the state for at least five (5) continuous years immediately prior to membership, who does not at the time of his appointment hold a license issued by the board entitling him to be a pharmacy technician in the state, who is not a citizen of the United
