AN ACT relating to the Wyoming Criminal History Record Act; authorizing dissemination of criminal history record information on prospective employees to fire departments, ambulance services providers and local and regional emergency response teams as specified; authorizing fire departments, ambulance service providers and local and regional emergency response teams to require applicants to submit fingerprints for criminal history record purposes; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 7-19-106(a) by creating a new paragraph (xii) and 7-19-201 by creating a new subsection (e) are amended to read:

7-19-106. Access to, and dissemination of, information.

(a) Criminal history record information shall be disseminated by criminal justice agencies in this state, whether directly or through any intermediary, only to:

(xii) Any public or private fire department, ambulance service or local or regional emergency response team, using paid employees or volunteers on a full-time or part-time basis, for purposes of obtaining state and national criminal history record information on prospective employees who will respond to emergencies as an employee or volunteer of the fire department, ambulance service or local or regional emergency response team.

(e) Any public or private fire department, ambulance service or regional emergency response team may as a condition of employment or other participation with the entity require all applicants for employee or volunteer positions with the entity to submit to fingerprinting in order to obtain state and national criminal history record information.

Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2005.
