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1 (a) All individual or group health insurance policies 2 providing coverage on an expense incurred basis, individual and group service or indemnity type health insurance 3 4 contracts issued by any insurer, including any nonprofit 5 corporation and individual and group service contracts 6 issued by a health maintenance organization, shall provide 7 coverage for the treatment of substance abuse that is no less extensive than the coverage provided for any other 8 9 physical illness. Private third party payors shall not eliminate coverage due to the requirements of this section. 10 11

12 (b) As used in this section, "substance abuse" means 13 the excessive use of alcohol or controlled substances to 14 the extent that the use interferes with activities of daily 15 living, employment or social relationships.

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17 Section 2. This act shall apply to any individual or 18 group health insurance policy or plan that is delivered, 19 issued, renewed, modified, amended or extended on or after 20 July 1, 2006. The provisions of this act do not supercede 21 or take precedence over federal laws governing health 22 insurance plans.
