8 **Section 1.** W.S. 35-9-103(c) is amended to read:

- 13 (c) The board consists of $\frac{\text{three}}{\text{(3)}}$ five (5) members
- 14 appointed by the governor for six (6) year terms. At least
- one (1) member and no more than two (2) members shall be $\frac{a}{a}$

1 journeyman electrician journeymen electricians, at least one (1) and no more than two (2) shall be a master 2 3 electrician master electricians, and at least one (1) and 4 no more than two (2) shall be an electrical contractor 5 electrical contractors. No two (2) members shall be employed by the same entity and serve on the board. Any 6 7 member who becomes employed by the same entity as another member during his term of office shall resign from the 8 board immediately. Vacancies shall be filled for the 9 10 unexpired term. When new appointments are made, the board 11 shall select a chairman and a secretary. A quorum consists of $\frac{two}{2}$ three (3) members. The board shall meet at 12 13 least twice each year. 14 15 Section 2. Notwithstanding the six (6) year term provided in W.S. 35-9-103(c), the initial term of one (1) 16 17 member of the electrical board appointed under this act shall expire on March 1, 2010. 18 19 20 Section 3.
