A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to counties; authorizing county
2 commissioners to hire county administrators; providing for
3 a maximum salary; providing for duties of a county
4 administrator; and providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 18-3-107 by creating a new subsection
9 (g) and 18-3-504(a) (ix) and by creating a new paragraph (x)
10 are amended to read:

12 **18-3-107. Annual salaries of certain officers;**
13 **additional compensation prohibited; exception as to**
14 **traveling and other expenses; compensation of county**

1 **commissioner; appointment and salaries of deputies, clerks,**
2 **stenographers and other assistants.**

3
4 (g) The board of county commissioners of any county
5 may appoint one (1) or more county administrators as may be
6 necessary to properly administer the ministerial acts and
7 administrative functions of the county commission. No
8 county administrator shall receive more than the lowest
9 compensation paid any elected county officer in the same
10 county who serves full-time as specified in W.S. 18-3-106.

12 **18-3-504. Powers and duties generally.**

13
14 (a) Each board of county commissioners may:

15
16 (ix) By resolution, prohibit or authorize and
17 regulate the operation of golf carts as defined by W.S. 31-
18 5-102(a)(lxi) on public roads and streets within
19 unincorporated areas of the county. ~~;~~;

21 (x) Appoint one (1) or more county
22 administrators as may be necessary to properly administer
23 the ministerial acts and administrative functions of the
24 commission as authorized by the commission.

2 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2006.
