AN ACT relating to alcoholic beverages; allowing direct
shipment of wine; providing limitations; and providing for
an effective date.
Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:
Section 1. W.S. 12-4-412 by creating new subsections
(e) through (g) is amended to read:
12-4-412. Microbrewery and winery permits;
authorized; conditions; dual permits and licenses;

(e) Notwithstanding subsection (b) (v) of this section

satellite winery permits; direct shipment of wine; fees.

15 and W.S. 12-5-201, any person holding a winery permit as

- 1 provided by this section, may sell and ship its
- 2 manufactured wine directly to any household in this state
- 3 in an amount totaling not more than eighteen (18) liters of
- 4 its manufactured wine in any twelve (12) month period.

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- 6 (f) Notwithstanding subsection (b) (v) of this section
- 7 and W.S. 12-5-201, any person holding a winery permit as
- 8 provided by this section, may sell and ship its
- 9 manufactured wine which is not listed with the liquor
- 10 division as part of its inventory and distribution
- 11 operation to any Wyoming retail establishment which holds a
- 12 liquor license in this state.

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- 14 (g) Any licensed winery holding a winery permit
- 15 pursuant to this section shall:

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- 17 (i) Not ship more than a total of eighteen (18)
- 18 liters of its own manufactured wine to any one (1)
- 19 household in this state during any twelve (12) month
- 20 period;

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- (ii) Offer to sell its manufactured wine to the
- 23 liquor division at wholesale prices if the winery ships
- 24 more than ninety (90) liters total of any of its

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manufactured wine to any combination of households or 1 2 licensed retailers in this state; 3 4 (iii) Ship its manufactured wine only to 5 individuals who are at least twenty-one (21) years of age 6 for such individual's personal use and not for resale; 7 (iv) Ensure that all shipping containers of 8 9 manufactured wine shipped pursuant to this section are 10 conspicuously labeled with the words: "CONTAINS ALCOHOLIC 11 BEVERAGES. ADULTS (OVER 21) SIGNATURE REQUIRED FOR 12 DELIVERY"; 13 14 (v) Ensure that all its shipments within this 15 state are made by a duly licensed carrier and further 16 ensure that such carriers comply with the requirement to 17 obtain an adult signature; 18 19 (vi) File a monthly report of wines shipped out 20 of state on a form provided by the liquor division and 21 include a copy of the invoice for each shipment of their 22 own manufactured wine subject to the following:

1	(A) The report shall be filed with the
2	liquor division not later than the tenth of the month
3	following the month in which the shipment was made;
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5	(B) Any report filed late with the liquor
6	division shall be subject to a late filing fee of twenty-
7	five dollars (\$25.00);
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9	(vii) Maintain records for at least three (3)
10	years that will permit the liquor division to ascertain the
11	truthfulness of the information filed and permit the
12	division to perform an audit of the licensee's records upon
13	reasonable request.
