9	Section 1. W.S. 12-4-201(d)(iii), (f)(ii) and (iii)

(d) Effective January 1, 1986, the number of retail 1 2 liquor licenses issued shall be based on the following 3 population formula:

5 (iii) Not more than one (1) additional license for each additional full three thousand (3,000) two five 6 7 hundred (2,500) population over nine thousand five hundred (9,500). 8

10 (f) Retail liquor licenses and malt beverage permits may be granted by the county commissioners as the 11 12 appropriate licensing authority in a county outside of incorporated cities and towns as follows: 13

15 (ii) No more than three (3) six (6) retail 16 liquor licenses issued for locations within five (5) miles 17 of the corporate limits of a city or town; and

18

19 (iii) Malt beverage permits may be issued for 20 county locations beyond a five (5) mile zone around 21 incorporated cities and towns without regard to 22 population-, but no more than three (3) malt beverage 23 permits shall be issued for locations within five (5) miles 24 of the corporate limits of a city or town.
