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14	(a) As used in this act:
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1	(i) "Resident" means a person, partnership,		
2	limited partnership, registered limited partnership,		
3	registered limited liability company or corporation		
4	certified as a resident by the department of employment		
5	prior to bidding upon the contract, subject to the		
6	following criteria <mark>:and subject to W.S. 16-6-102(d):</mark>		
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8	(A) Any person who has been a resident of		
9	the state for one (1) year or more immediately prior to		
10	bidding upon the contract; <u>or</u>

12	(B) A partnership <u>,</u> or association, each		
13	member of which has been a resident of <u>limited partnership</u> ,		
14	registered limited partnership, registered limited		
15	liability company or corporation which has maintained an		
16	office and place of business within the state for one (1)		
17	year or more immediately prior to bidding upon the

21	business" shall have the meaning as the department of		
22	employment determines, consistent with the purpose of this		
23	act, by rule and regulation; "Office" and "place of

Limitation on subcontracting by resident 16 17 contractors. 18 A successful resident bidder shall not subcontract 19 20 more than twenty percent (20%) fifty percent (50%) of the 21 work covered by his contract to nonresident contractors. 22 23 16-6-106. Statement of Wyoming materials preference 24 in requests for bids and proposals.

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2 All requests for bids and proposals for materials, 3 supplies, agricultural products, equipment, machinery and 4 provisions for the construction, maintenance and upkeep of 5 every state, county, municipal, community college district or school district institution shall contain the words 6 7 "preference is hereby given to materials, supplies, agricultural products, equipment, machinery and provisions 8 9 produced, manufactured, supplied or grown in Wyoming, or supplied by a resident of the state, quality being equal to 10 articles offered by the competitors outside of the state". 11 12 Section 2. W.S. 16-6-101(a)(i)(C) through (G) and 13 16-6-102(d)(i) are repealed. 14 15 16 Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2006. 17 18 (END)
