A BILL

for

AN ACT relating to health care providers; removing the 1 requirement that the department of health, in administering 2 loan repayment programs for physicians, dentists and allied 3 health care providers, consult with the department advisory 4 5 council; requiring the department to consult with licensing and professional associations, as 6 boards specified; 7 removing a restriction on eligible physician and dentist loans to post-undergraduate loans; authorizing 8 loan reimbursement for speech language pathologists; removing a 9 local matching funds requirement for allied health care 10 11 provider loan reimbursements; providing priority for 12 Wyoming graduates in loan reimbursement agreements; 13 providing appropriations; authorizing an additional position; and providing for an effective date. 14

16 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 9-2-118(a)(ii) and (b) and

9 (a) The department is authorized to enter into
10 agreements with physicians and dentists who have graduated
11 from accredited residency programs to provide health care

12 in this state. The agreements shall:

(ii) Provide that the physician or dentist shall be repaid up to one hundred percent (100%) of the amount of outstanding educational loans the physician or dentist has acquired after completing undergraduate programs and as a direct result of medical or dental school training, not to exceed thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000.00) per year, including the matching funds specified in subsection (d) of this section, in exchange for practicing his profession

1 (b) The department, in consultation with the departmental advisory council appropriate licensing board 2 and professional association, shall promulgate 3 4 necessary to carry out the purposes of this section. In 5 carrying out this section the department shall assess health care needs of the state by geographic areas and 6 practice specialties and shall prioritize and enter into 7

13 (a) The department is authorized to enter 14 agreements with health care providers licensed or certified 15 to provide health care services in this state including, but not limited to, hospital, medical, surgical, dental, 16 17 vision, nursing, radiology, mental health, speech language 18 pathology and pharmaceutical services. The agreements 19 shall:

21 (ii) Provide that the health care provider shall 22 be repaid up to one hundred percent (100%) of the amount of outstanding educational loans the provider has acquired as 23 24 result of educational training directly related to

- providing medical services, not to exceed ten thousand 1
- 2 dollars (\$10,000.00) per year, including the matching funds
- specified in subsection (d) of this section, in exchange 3
- 4 for practicing under the terms of this section;
