## A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to taxation and revenue; providing for the
- 2 distribution of severance taxes as specified; providing for
- 3 the funding of multi-lane highways as specified; conforming
- 4 related provisions; providing for application of the act;
- 5 and providing for an effective date.

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7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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9 **Section 1.** W.S. 39-14-801(d)(intro) and (e)(i) and by 10 creating a new paragraph (xi) is amended to read:

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39-14-801. Severance tax distributions; distribution account created; formula.

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15 (a) There is created the severance tax distribution 16 account into which shall be credited revenues from 17 severance taxes as provided by law. Interest on earnings 18 from funds in the account shall be credited to the general 19 fund.

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21 (b) Before making distributions from the severance 22 tax distribution account under subsections (c) through (e)

of this section, an amount equal to two-thirds (2/3) of the amount of tax collected under W.S. 39-14-104(a)(i) and (b)(i) and 39-14-204(a)(i) for the same period shall be deposited into the permanent Wyoming mineral trust fund.

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(c) [LUST] Before making distributions from severance tax distribution account under subsections (d) and (e) of this section, an amount equal to the amount of 39-17-104(a)(iii) collected under W.S. 39-17-204(a)(ii) for the same period shall be distributed to the corrective action account created by W.S. 35-11-1424 and to the financial responsibility account created by W.S. 35-11-1427 in an inverse proportion to the amount in the two (2) accounts.

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(d) After making distributions under subsections (b) and (c) of this section, distributions under subsection (e) of this section shall be made from the severance tax distribution account. The amount of distributions under subsection (e) of this section shall not exceed one hundred fifty-five million dollars (\$155,000,000.00) two hundred million dollars (\$200,000,000.00) in any fiscal year. To the extent that distributions under subsection (e) of this section would exceed that amount in any fiscal year, the excess shall be credited:

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(i) One-third (1/3) to the general fund; and

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(ii) Two-thirds (2/3) to the budget reserve account.

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(e) Deposits into the account created by subsection of this section shall be distributed as follows, subject to subsections (b) through (d) of this section:

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To the general fund, sixty-two and twentysix hundredths percent (62.26%) forty-eight and twenty-five hundredths percent (48.25%);

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(ii) To water development account I under W.S. 41-2-124(a)(i), twelve and forty-five hundredths percent (12.45%);

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44 (iii) To water development account II under W.S. 41-2-124(a)(ii), two and one tenth percent (2.1%); 45

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(iv) To the highway fund, four and thirty-three hundredths percent (4.33%), except that if the total unencumbered revenues within the state park road account created by W.S. 24-14-102 are less than five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000.00) on July 1, 2001 or on July 1 of any even-numbered year thereafter, the state treasurer shall first distribute revenues to that account in an amount equal to five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000.00) less the total unencumbered revenues in the account on July 1 of that year;

(v) To counties, seventy-eight hundredths
percent (0.78%), subject to the following formula:

(A) Fifty percent (50%) of the funds distributed under this paragraph shall be distributed to the counties in the same proportion that the population of the county bears to the population of the state as determined by the most recent decennial census; and

(B) Fifty percent (50%) of the funds distributed under this subsection shall be distributed to the counties based upon the inverse of the assessed valuation of each county as computed under subparagraph (vii)(C) of this subsection.

 (vi) To counties, three and one-tenth percent (3.1%), each county to receive an amount in the proportion which the population of the county bears to total state population, population to be determined by resort to the latest federal census as periodically updated by the bureau of the census;

(vii) To the road construction funds of the various counties as provided by W.S. 24-2-110, two and nine-tenths percent (2.9%), except that each county's share of funds under this subsection shall be computed as follows:

(A) One-third (1/3) shall be distributed to each county in the ratio that the population of the county bears to total state population based on the most recent decennial federal census;

 (B) One-third (1/3) shall be distributed to each county in the ratio that the mileage of county roads in the county bears to total county roads in Wyoming;

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1 2 (C) One-third (1/3) shall be distributed to 3 each county as follows: 4 5 (I) Arrange the assessed valuation of each county in descending order by county; 6 7 8 (II) Calculate the county percentages 9 of assessed valuation relative to total state valuation; 10 11 (III) Calculate the inverse of the county percentage of total state assessed valuation by 12 13 dividing one (1) by the percentage computed in subdivision 14 (C)(II) of this paragraph; 15 16 (IV) Compute each county share by 17 dividing each inverse calculated under subdivision (III) of 18 this subparagraph by the total sum of the inverses 19 calculated under subdivision (III) of this subparagraph. 20 21 (viii) To cities and towns, nine and twenty-five 22 hundredths percent (9.25%), each city or town to receive an amount in the proportion which the population of the city 23 24 or town bears to the population of all cities and towns in 25 Wyoming, population to be determined by resort to the 26 latest federal census as periodically updated by the bureau 27 of the census; 28 29 (ix) To the capital construction account, two 30 and thirty-three hundredths percent (2.33%), to be expended 31 for the purposes specified in W.S. 9-4-604(k)(ii); 32 33 (x) To the water development account III, five-34 tenths of one percent (.5%), to be expended for the 35 purposes specified in W.S. 41-2-124(d). 36 37 (xi) To an account within the highway fund to be 38 designated as the multi-lane highway funding account, 39 fourteen and one hundredth percent (14.01%), to be expended for the purposes of constructing and maintaining multi-lane 40 41 highways in this state. 42 43 Section 2. This act shall apply to distributions of 44 fiscal year 2007 revenues, and thereafter. 45 46 Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2006.
