- 11 (a) There is created the state assessed property task
- 12 force to study the property tax classification of
- 13 industrial and commercial property. The task force shall
- 14 consist of seven (7) members as follows:

1 (i) Three (3) members of the senate appointed by 2 the president, with two (2) members from the majority party 3 and one (1) member from the minority party; 4 5 (ii) Four (4) members of the house of representatives appointed by the speaker, with three (3) 6 7 members from the majority party and one (1) member from the minority party. 8 9 10 (b) At its first meeting, the task force shall elect 11 a chairman to preside over the meetings. The department of 12 shall provide necessary administrative revenue 13 technical assistance to the task force in carrying out the 14 study authorized by this section. 15 16 (c) The task force shall: 17 (i) Study the composition of the current 18 valorem tax classification of industrial and commercial 19 20 properties, and any proposals for changes; 21 22 (ii) Study the department's methodology assessment and valuation for state assessed properties, and 23

8 governor and the joint revenue interim committee not later

13 fund twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00), or as much

14 thereof as is necessary, to the legislative service office

15 for the purposes of this act.

17 **Section 3.** This act is effective immediately upon

18 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

19 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming

20 Constitution.
