A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to education; clarifying provisions
- 2 regarding students attending multiple institutions under
- 3 the Hathaway scholarship program; and providing for an
- 4 effective date.

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6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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- 8 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-16-1308(a)(iv) and (v) and (c) is
- 9 amended to read:

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21-16-1308. Administration; rules and regulations.

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- 13 (a) This article shall be administered by the
- 14 department in accordance with the following:

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1 (iv) Each eligible institution receiving an 2 application from a student applying for a Hathaway 3 scholarship shall preliminarily determine the student's 4 eligibility for the scholarship. For students initially 5 applying for a scholarship, unless the student's complete academic record is available, the GPA used to preliminarily 6 7 determine eligibility shall be based upon the student's official high school transcript after either the end of the 8 9 first semester of a student's senior year or the second 10 semester of a student's junior year, at the sole discretion 11 of the eligible institution. For students graduating prior 12 their senior year the GPA used to preliminarily 13 determine eligibility shall be based upon the student's 14 official high school transcript as of the end of the semester immediately prior to the last semester before the 15 16 student's graduation. High school for GPAs final 17 eligibility determinations for students initially applying for a scholarship under this article shall be based upon 18 the student's complete high school academic record. 19 20 determination of scholarship eligibility, 21 community college shall certify to the community college 22 commission not later than thirty (30) days after the semester commences, a list of students enrolled at the 23 24 institution who qualify for a scholarship under this

1 article, including the amount of each scholarship. The 2 university shall certify to the department within forty-3 five (45) days after the semester commences a like list for 4 students enrolled at the university. The director of the 5 community college commission shall verify within ten (10) days after receiving all lists from community colleges that 6 7 whether there is no any duplication of students on the community college lists, shall provide the lists to the 8 9 department and shall certify to the department the amount 10 each college is to receive under this article. Students 11 attending more than one (1) eligible institution shall 12 enter into a consortium agreement with the multiple 13 institutions whereby the student shall designate a home 14 institution to be paid the entire Hathaway scholarship 15 amount for which the student qualifies;

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 (∇) The department shall determine and certify to the state treasurer the amount which is equal to seventy-five percent (75%) of the total amount the eligible institution received during the preceding semester under subsection. Not later than September 1 for the fall semester and not later than January 15 for the spring from the semester, the state treasurer shall pay scholarship expenditure account the amount certified by the

1 department. The department shall review the lists provided 2 under paragraph (iv) of this subsection, determine whether 3 there is no any duplication of students, and determine and 4 certify to the state treasurer the balance of the amount 5 due under this article to each institution for the For any duplication, the department shall 6 7 determine whether the student is attending more than one (1) eligible institution. If the student is attending 8 9 multiple eligible institutions payment of the Hathaway 10 scholarship for which the student qualifies shall be made 11 only to the institution designated as the home institution 12 by the student. The state treasurer shall pay from the 13 scholarship expenditure account the balance of the amount 14 Payments of the balance due under this paragraph shall be made not later than seventy-five (75) days after 15 the institution's semester has commenced. Payments to the 16 17 university shall be made directly to the university. Payments to the community colleges shall be made directly 18 to each college and be reported by the state treasurer to 19 20 the community college commission. Should a prepayment 21 under this paragraph exceed the amount actually due the 22 institution for any semester, the excess amount shall be calculated by the department and deducted from the next 23 24 payment made. For purposes of this subsection, payments

 $1\,$ due for summer terms shall be included within the

2 calculations and payments for the subsequent fall semester.

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4 (C) The department shall establish annual reporting 5 procedures for purposes of policy analysis and program evaluation and providing accurate data to the legislature 6 7 and governor relative to the program's impact on the state students. In developing the annual 8 reporting 9 procedure the department shall consult with the University 10 of Wyoming and community college financial aid officers and 11 registrars or their designees. It is the intention of the 12 legislature that the reporting system and the requirements 13 thereof shall be applicable to all recipients scholarships under this article. Compliance with this 14 made a condition of receiving a 15 section shall be 16 scholarship under this article. For any student attending 17 than one (1) eligible institution, the home institution shall be responsible for data reporting for 18 19 that student, and any other eligible institution shall 20 cooperate as necessary with the home institution to fulfill 21 that duty. The reporting system shall include the following 22 information:
