This amendment would remove the requirement that four years of math be taken in grades 912. The same four levels of math specified in the bill would be required, but the amendment would allow a student to take Algebra I and the other courses specified in eighth grade or even earlier. The student would not be required to take four additional years of math in grades 9-12. The limited exception to the " 4 years in grades $9-12$," which is currently in the bill, is removed as unnecessary.
