A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to mental health and substance abuse

2 services; providing appropriations; providing continuous

3 appropriations; specifying conditions; authorizing

4 positions; continuing a study of mental health and

5 substance abuse service delivery systems; and providing for

6 effective dates.

7

8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

9

10 Section 1. Wyoming state hospital co-occurring

11 conditions treatment program.

12

13 (a) There is appropriated three hundred eighty-three

14 thousand six hundred sixty dollars (\$383,660.00), or as

15 much thereof as is necessary, from the general fund to the

Wyoming state hospital, for the fiscal year beginning July 1

2 1, 2007. The funds appropriated under this subsection

3 shall only be used to implement a program to treat

4 individuals with co-occurring diagnoses of serious,

5 persistent mental illness and alcohol/substance abuse,

dependence or addiction. The program shall provide initial 6

7 psychiatric symptom stabilization, followed by a treatment

intervention, using multi-therapeutic interventions 8

9 include social integration and rehabilitation, vocational

quidance and individualized recovery and rehabilitation 10

11 goals to manage the person's mental illness and substance

12 abuse issues.

13

14 (b) The Wyoming state hospital is authorized eight

(8) full-time equivalent positions to implement the program 15

specified in subsection (a) of this section. 16

18 The department of health shall include a request

in its 2009-2010 standard budget request for purposes of 19

20 continuing funding of the program specified in subsection

21 (a) of this section and the positions authorized under

22 subsection (b) of this section.

1 Section 2. Regional residential treatment for persons

4 There is appropriated one million six hundred 5 fifty-seven thousand seven hundred dollars (\$1,657,700.00), or as much thereof as is necessary, from the general fund 6 to the department of health, for the fiscal year beginning 7 July 1, 2007. The funds appropriated under this subsection 8 9 shall only be used to fund not more than two (2) treatment 10 facilities in the state to serve persons with co-occurring 11 disorders of mental illness and alcohol or substance abuse. 12 The funding shall be expended to serve not more than twelve 13 (12) clients at any given time in each of the facilities selected by the department of health, in consultation with 14 mental health division and the substance 15 the

The 15 funds appropriated under this subsection shall be used to 16 17 enable community mental health centers to community-based housing and residential services 18 for clients with serious and persistent mental illness. 19 20 residential services shall include appropriate support to 21 enable the residents in the housing to develop or improve 22 daily living skills, including self-care, meal preparation, shopping and budgeting proficiencies so the client may 23 24 successfully remain in an independent living situation.
