Section 1. W.S. 9-2-102(a)(iii) is amended to read:

(iii) Establish minimum standards and approve

1 (a) The department of health is the state mental 2 health authority, the developmental disabilities authority 3 and the substance abuse authority. The department through 4 its divisions has the following duties and responsibilities 5 to:

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policies and procedures for the establishment and operation 8 9 community-based mental health, substance abuse and of 10 developmental disabilities programs receiving 11 support. The department through its mental health division 12 and its substance abuse divisions shall annually withhold 13 not less than five percent (5%) of all amounts provided in 14 each contract with a community-based mental health or 15 substance abuse program and shall not release the funds 16 withheld to the individual program until the respective 17 division and the individual program enter into an agreement 18 that provides for performance measures. If the respective 19 division and an individual program do not enter into a 20 mutually agreed upon set of performance measures, the funds 21 withheld under this paragraph shall revert to the budget 22 reserve account at the end of the biennium in which the 23 funds were withheld;

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Section 2. W.S. 9-2-102(a)(iii), as amended by this 1

2 act, shall apply to any contract entered into between the

department of health, mental health division or substance 3

4 abuse division, and a community-based mental health or

5 substance abuse provider on or after July 1, 2007.

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Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2007. 7
