_0	Section 1. W.S. 35-9-162 is created to read:

1 (a) An account is created to be known as the Wyoming

2 fire training facility grant account.

3

4 (b) The state fire marshal may expend funds from the

5 fire training facility grant account for staffing and other

6 administrative expenses authorized under this section and

7 for grants to local governments for the improvement of fire

8 training facilities as provided in this section.

9

10 (c) The state fire marshal shall receive and evaluate

11 applications for grants from the fire training facility

12 grant account. Funds in the account are continuously

13 appropriated for grants approved by the state fire marshal.

14

15 (d) The state fire marshal shall adopt rules and

16 regulations in accordance with the Wyoming Administrative

17 Procedure Act as necessary to carry out his duties under

18 this section, including rules to:

19

20 (i) Establish criteria for grants from the fire

21 training facility improvement account which accomplish the

22 purposes of this section, including the following:

23

1	(A) Grants shall be distributed taking into
2	account the training needs of the fire protection community
3	throughout the state;
4	
5	(B) Grants shall be distributed taking into
6	consideration the accessibility of the facility to a broad
7	spectrum of fire services throughout the state;
8	
9	(C) No individual local government shall
10	receive grants in excess of seven hundred thousand dollars
11	(\$700,000.00) per year for each facility;
12	
13	(D) Grants shall only be used for
14	improvement of fire protection training facilities and
15	shall not be used for operation or maintenance of any local
16	government program;
17	
18	(E) Grants shall be distributed taking into
19	account the recommendations of the state of Wyoming fire
20	training study committee completed in July, 2006.
21	

(ii) Establish criteria for matching funds or 22 23 other in-kind contributions from grantees which shall not

1	exceed	а	10%	match	requirement	and	shall	be	consistent

2 among grant recipients;

4 (iii) Evaluate, rank and prioritize grant

5 proposals;

7 (iv) Review and monitor grants to grantees;

8

9 (v) Evaluate the effects of grant proposals on

10 the availability and improvement of fire training

11 facilities in local governments throughout the state.

13 (e) The state fire marshal shall annually report to

14 the governor, the joint appropriations interim committee

15 and the joint corporations, elections and political

16 subdivisions interim committee no later than December 1

17 with respect to all grants awarded and progress made by the

18 recipient of all grants awarded under this section.
