A BILL
for

AN ACT relating to cities and towns; authorizing cities and towns to appoint municipal animal control officers who are not certified as peace officers; authorizing municipal animal control officers to issue citations to persons as specified; conforming provisions; providing limitations; providing a definition; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: Section 1. W.S. 7-2-103 by creating a new subsection (e) and 15-1-103(a) by creating a new paragraph (xlx) is amended to read:

7-2-103. Issuance of citations.

    (e) For purposes of this section, "issuing officer"
means a peace officer, or a municipal animal control
officer acting in accordance with the terms of his
appointment under W.S. 15-1-103(a)(xlx).
```

    15-1-103. General powers of governing bodies.
    (a) The governing bodies of all cities and towns may:
        (xlx) Appoint municipal animal control officers
        who are not certified as peace officers to issue citations
    to individuals while enforcing ordinances, resolutions and
    regulations adopted under paragraph (xiv) of this
subsection or other municipal animal control ordinances
adopted for the purposes of protecting public health and
safety, advancing the humane and safe treatment of animals
or mitigating public nuisances caused by animals.
Municipal animal control officers are not law enforcement
officers for purposes of employee benefits provided in
Title 9 of Wyoming statutes.
Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2007.
