9 **Section 1.** W.S. 37-15-413 is created to read:

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- 11 37-15-413. Limitation on authority of political
- 12 subdivision to enter exclusive agreement for provision of
- 13 telecommunications service.

1 (a) Except as provided in subsections (b), (c) and (d)

2 of this section, no governing body of any city or town or

3 other political subdivision of this state, shall provide

4 for the construction, maintenance or operation of any

5 telecommunications service by entering into an exclusive

6 franchise, partnership, joint venture, contract, resale

7 agreement or any other agreement with any party.

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9 (b) Nothing in this section shall be construed to

10 restrict the governing body of a city or town or other

11 political subdivision, from allowing the nondiscriminatory

use of its rights-of-way including its poles, conduits, 12

13 ducts or similar support structures by a telecommunications

14 company.

subdivision, from providing a telecommunications service or 18
