Harboring a sex offender; penalties; 12 exceptions. 13 (a) A person is guilty of a felony, if the person has 14 reason to believe that a sex offender who is required to 15

register under W.S. 7-19-302 is not complying, or has not 1 2 complied, with the requirements of W.S. 7-19-302 and: 3 (i) Intends to assist the sex offender 4 in 5 eluding a law enforcement agency that is seeking to question the sex offender about, or to arrest the sex 6 7 offender for, his noncompliance with the requirements of W.S. 7-19-302 or any other law prohibiting a sexual 8 9 offense, child abuse or kidnapping; 10

11 (ii) Withholds information, including but not 12 limited to the location of the sex offender, from, or fails 13 to notify, the law enforcement agency about the sex offender's noncompliance with the requirements of W.S. 14 7-19-302 or any other law prohibiting a sexual offense, 15 16 child abuse or kidnapping;

(iii) Harbors, or attempts to harbor, or assists 18 19 another person in harboring or attempting to harbor, the 20 sex offender;

22 (iv) Conceals or attempts to conceal, or assists another person in concealing or attempting to conceal, the 23 24 sex offender; or

2 (v) Provides information to the law enforcement 3 agency regarding the sex offender which the person knows to 4 be false.

6 (b) Subsection (a) of this section shall not apply if 7 the sex offender is incarcerated in a local, state or 8 federal detention or correctional facility, or is in the 9 custody of a law enforcement agency.

10

11 (c) The penalty for a violation of subsection (a) of 12 this section is the same penalty for the most serious crime 13 for which the sex offender who is being harbored is charged, except if the person violating subsection (a) of 14 this section is convicted for the first time of harboring a 15 sex offender who is charged with a second or subsequent 16 17 violation of W.S. 7-19-307, the person convicted under this section shall only be subject to the penalty under W.S. 7-18 19-307(c). 19

2	(c) A person who knowingly fails to register as
3	required by W.S. 7-19-302 is guilty of a high misdemeanor
4	felony punishable by a fine of up to seven hundred fifty
5	dollars (\$750.00) five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00),
6	imprisonment for not <u>less than one (1) year nor</u> more than
7	one (1) year <u>five (5) years</u>, or both.
8	
9	(d) A person convicted of a subsequent violation of
10	knowingly failing to register as required by W.S. 7-19-302
11	is guilty of a felony punishable by a fine of one thousand
12	dollars (\$1,000.00) ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00),
13	imprisonment for not <u>less than one (1) year nor</u> more than
14	five (5) ten (10) years, or both.
15	
16	Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2007.
