1 AN ACT relating to the Wyoming supreme court; authorizing 2 the supreme court to establish pilot projects to reimburse 3 law enforcement agencies for court security as specified; 4 providing procedures for implementation of the pilot 5 projects; providing an appropriation; requiring a report; 6 and providing for an effective date.

12 (a) For the period beginning with the effective date 13 of this act and ending June 30, 2008, there is appropriated 14 five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000.00) from the 15 general fund, or as much thereof as necessary, to the

1 Wyoming supreme court to establish and administer not more 2 than three (3) pilot projects in the state to reimburse law 3 enforcement agencies providing security for court 4 facilities within the pilot projects. The appropriation 5 under this section shall be subject to the following: 6 7 (i) board of judicial policy and The administration shall recommend to the supreme court: 8 9 10 (A) Rules and regulations governing 11 standards for the provision of security for court 12 facilities within the pilot projects; 13 14 (B) The amount of funding each pilot project authorized by this section shall be awarded; 15 16 17 (C) The courts within the pilot projects which may be eliqible for reimbursement for security 18 provided by law enforcement agencies; 19 20 21 (D) The additional training that may be 22 necessary for court security and the extent to which the training will be reimbursed; and 23 24

(E) Levels of reimbursement to the law 1 2 enforcement agencies selected to provide court security 3 within the pilot projects. 4 5 (ii) The supreme court shall: 6 7 (A) Require each court eligible for reimbursement under this section to enter into an agreement 8 9 with an appropriate law enforcement agency to provide court security to the court as identified in the agreement, 10 11 including specifying any additional law enforcement 12 training that may be necessary for court security;

(B) Distribute funds to the courts eligible 14 for funding under this section to reimburse the law 15 enforcement agencies in accordance with the agreements 16 17 executed under subparagraph (A) of this paragraph.

19 The supreme court shall report no later than (b) 20 November 1, 2007 to the joint appropriations interim committee and the joint judiciary interim committee on the 21 22 effectiveness and costs of implementing court security under the pilot projects authorized by this section, 23 including recommendations whether to continue or terminate 24

the pilot projects, or to expand and enhance the court 1 2 security program to other court facilities not covered by the pilot projects authorized by this section. 3 4 5 Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law 6 7 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution. 8 9 (END)
