1 (f) Notwithstanding subsection (e) of this section, a 2 district may expend up to ten percent (10%) of the amount 3 distributed during any school year under subsection (b) of 4 this section for major building and facility repair and 5 replacement needs of the district which are not specified in the district's facility plan, including expenditures for 6 maintenance of district enhancements. Expenditures shall 7 be made under this subsection only after the district's 8 9 building and facility repair and replacement needs 10 specified in its facility plan have been addressed in 11 accordance with subsection (e) of this section and the 12 approved the district's commission has proposed 13 expenditures under this subsection. Any amount not 14 expended by the district under this subsection during any 15 school year shall not accumulate to the next school year 16 but shall at the end of the applicable school year, revert 17 to that portion of the separate account established under subsection (e) of this section which is restricted to 18 19 funding expenses incurred for the district's major building 20 and facility repair and replacement needs specified within 21 its facility plan. Each district shall include 22 expenditures under this subsection within the annual report required under subsection (e) of this section. Nothing in 23 24 this subsection shall prohibit or limit the application of

subparagraph (c)(i)(D) of this section in computing a 1 2 district's building and facility gross square footage for purposes of determining payment amounts under this section. 3 4 If any school district exceeds expenditure limitations 5 prescribed by this subsection or fails to comply with expenditure levels for facility adequacy needs identified 6 7 within its facility plan, the payments for that district in the immediately succeeding year shall be reduced by the 8 9 excess expenditure amount. 10 11 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2007. 12
