9	paragraph (xv) and 7-19-201(a) by creating a new paragraph

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1	(a) Criminal history record information shall be
2	disseminated by criminal justice agencies in this state,
3	whether directly or through any intermediary, only to:

5	(xv) The military department for purposes of
6	obtaining criminal history record information on
7	prospective employees or volunteers.

9	7-19-201. State or national criminal history record
10	information.

12	(a) The following persons shall be required to submit
13	to fingerprinting in order to obtain state and national
14	criminal history record information:
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16	(viii) Prospective employees of or volunteers
17	with the Wyoming military department if the department
18	requires prospective employees or volunteers, or both, to
19	submit to fingerprinting in order to obtain state and
20	national criminal history record information as a condition
21	for a position with the department.

23	(e) <u>The Wyoming military department, a</u> ny public fire

24 department, ambulance service or regional emergency

response team may as a condition of employment or other 1 2 participation with the entity require all applicants for 3 employee or volunteer positions with the entity to submit 4 to fingerprinting in order to obtain state and national 5 criminal history record information. In addition, the 6 office of homeland security may as a condition of 7 participation in a regional emergency response team require all team participants to submit to fingerprinting in order 8 to obtain state and national criminal history record 9 information. 10 11 12 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2007.
