## A BILL

## for

1	AN ACT relating to the veterans' commission; amending the
2	term of commission chairman, as specified; providing for
3	appointment of an executive secretary of the commission;
4	specifying duties of the executive secretary; and providing
5	for an effective date.

7	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:
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9	Section 1. W.S. 19-14-107(a) and by creating a new
10	subsection (d) is amended to read:
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12	19-14-107. Creation of veterans' commission;
13	composition; terms.
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1 (a) A Wyoming veterans' commission is created within 2 the military department consisting of twelve (12) members, 3 not less than one (1) of whom shall reside in each judicial 4 district identified in W.S. 5-3-101, appointed by the 5 governor for staggered terms of three (3) years. Commencing with initial appointments made in 2005, four (4) 6 7 members of the board shall be appointed for a term of one (1) year, four (4) members for a term of two (2) years and 8 9 four (4) members for a term of three (3) years. Terms thereafter shall be three (3) years and staggered with one-10 11 third (1/3) of the members' terms expiring each year. 12 Appointments shall be made without regard to political 13 affiliation, sex, religion or ethnic background. The 14 governor may remove any member as provided in W.S. 9-1-202. A chairman shall be elected by the commission from among 15 16 its members and a new chairman elected every two (2) years 17 annually thereafter. No person shall serve more than two 18 (2) consecutive terms as chairman.

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20 (d) The governor shall appoint an executive secretary 21 of the commission from a list of three (3) qualified 22 candidates submitted by the commission. The executive 23 secretary shall serve at the pleasure of the governor and 24 may be removed as provided in W.S. 9-1-202. The executive

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1	secretary shall be a non-voting member of the commission.
2	Under the direction of the commission, the executive
3	secretary shall manage the daily operations of the
4	commission and perform other duties assigned by the
5	commission and the adjutant general. The position of
6	executive secretary shall be within the organization and
7	budget of the military department, under the supervision of
8	the adjutant general, and shall be paid a salary as
9	determined by the department of administration and
10	information.
11	
12	Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2007.
