## A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to gambling; amending definitions;

- 2 clarifying that profit from gambling does not include
- 3 benefits of proprietorship; providing standards for bingo
- 4 games; limiting games to charitable and non profit
- 5 organizations existing for three years; limiting persons
- 6 authorized to operate games; specifying uses for proceeds
- 7 of bingo games; and providing for an effective date.

9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

- 11 **Section 1.** W.S. 6-7-101(a)(iii)(D), by creating a new
- 12 subparagraph (J), (ix), by creating a new paragraph (xi)
- 13 and by creating a new paragraph (xii) is amended to read:

15 **6-7-101.** Definitions.

2 (a) As used in this article:

3

(iii) "Gambling" means risking any property for gain contingent in whole or in part upon lot, chance, the operation of a gambling device or the happening or outcome of an event, including a sporting event, over which the person taking a risk has no control, but does not include:

(D) Raffles or Bingo games conducted, or

pull tabs sold, by charitable or nonprofit organizations

where the tickets for the raffle or bingo are sold only in

this state and the pull tabs are sold only on the premises

owned or occupied by the charitable or nonprofit

organization; provided that:

17 <u>(I) Bingo games and pull tab games</u>
18 <u>shall only be conducted by charitable or nonprofit</u>
19 <u>organizations, which have been in operation in this state</u>
20 for at least three (3) years;

21

22 <u>(II) In conducting bingo games and</u>
23 <u>pull tab games the organization shall use only volunteers</u>
24 who are bona fide members of the charitable or nonprofit

1	organization or employees who are paid by the organization
2	to assist in the operation of the game;
3	
4	(III) At least sixty-five percent
5	(65%) of all proceeds collected shall be redeemed as
6	winnings each month;
7	
8	(IV) Players of bingo games or pull
9	tab games shall be eighteen (18) years or older;
10	
11	(V) The charitable or nonprofit
12	organization conducting the bingo game or pull tab game may
13	purchase supplies or equipment necessary to conduct the
14	game from a distributor or manufacturer at a price based or
15	a per card or pull tab basis and a minimum of sixty percent
16	(60%) of the gross sales less the prizes paid shall be
17	retained by the charitable or nonprofit organization
18	conducting the bingo game or pull tab game after payment to
19	the distributor or manufacturer;
20	
21	(VI) Of the amount retained by the
22	charitable or nonprofit organization conducting the binge
23	game or pull tab game after payment of winnings and costs,
24	at least seventy-five percent (75%) shall be donated within

1 one (1) year by the organization to a bona fide charitable 2 or benevolent purpose; 3 4 Raffles conducted for charitable (J) 5 purposes. 6 (ix) "Profit" means benefit other than a gain, 7 which is realized or unrealized and direct or indirect, 8 9 including benefits from proprietorship, management or unequal advantage in a series of transactions but does not 10 11 include benefits of proprietorship or management of a 12 business wherein a game, wager or transaction described in 13 W.S. 6-7-101(iii)(E) occurs; 14 (xi) "Charitable or nonprofit organization" 15 16 means an organization recognized as a charitable or 17 nonprofit organization under Wyoming statutes and which possesses a valid exemption from federal income tax issued 18 by the Internal Revenue Service under the provisions of 26 19 20 U.S.C. § 501(c); 21 22 (xii) "Bingo game" means a game of chance in 23 which a prize or prizes are awarded to a player or players 24 who obtain a designated pattern or sequence of numbers or

numbers or symbols selected at random by a mechanical 2

3 blower or tumbler or a computer generated random generator

4 subject to the following:

5

6 (A) The bingo card shall be a paper, hard

7 card or electronically generated card, but an

electronically generated card shall be played only in 8

9 conjunction with a paper or hard card unless the player has

10 a disability that prevents the use of a paper or hard card.

The organization conducting the bingo game shall keep a 11

paper copy of all electronically generated cards offered, 12

13 used or sold on the premises;

14

15 (B) All players during the course of a

16 bingo game shall compete for the same prizes utilizing the

17 same set of numbers or symbols and shall share the same

18 deck or series of bingo cards for each game wherein no two

19 (2) cards distributed to the players are identical in the

20 same game and at least one (1) player shall win the prize

21 in each game played;

22

23 (C) There shall be minimum of two (2)

24 players participating in each game before a game can begin. (END)
