AN ACT relating to crimes and offenses; modifying penalty for eluding a peace officer; including eluding peace officers enforcing specified watercraft laws as an offense subject to a surcharge for the crime victims' compensation account; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 1-40-119(a)(ii) and 31-5-225(b) are amended to read:

1-40-119. Surcharge to be assessed in certain criminal cases; paid to account.

(a) In addition to any fine or other penalty prescribed by law, a defendant who pleads guilty or nolo contendere to, or is convicted of, the following criminal offenses shall be assessed a surcharge of not less than fifty dollars (\$50.00) for the offenses specified in paragraph (v) of this subsection and not less than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for the offenses specified in paragraphs (i) through (iv) of this subsection:

(ii) Any violation of W.S. 31-5-225, 31-5-229<u>,</u> or-31-5-233 or 41-13-220(a);

31-5-225. Fleeing or attempting to elude police officers; penalty.

(b) Every person convicted of fleeing or attempting to elude a police officer shall be punished by a fine of not more than seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00), or by imprisonment for not more than <u>ninety (90) days</u> six (6) months, or both.
