- 1 AN ACT relating to community college districts; requiring
- 2 the Wyoming community college commission to develop
- 3 recommendations on the organization of the state into

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8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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10 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-18-301 is amended to read:

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- 12 21-18-301. Community college district to be body
- 13 corporate; name.

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- 15 (a) Each community college district which is formed
- 16 under this act is a body corporate by the name and style of

1 ".... Community College District, State of Wyoming", the blank space to contain the chosen name of the district, and 2 3 in that name the district may hold property and be a party 4 to suits and contracts. 5 (b) Effective July 1, 2008, the state shall be 6 7 divided into community college districts in accordance with the statewide plan submitted by the Wyoming community 8 9 college commission and enacted by the 2008 Wyoming 10 legislature. 11 12 Section 2. 13 14 (a) The Wyoming community college commission shall in consultation with the established seven (7) community 15 16 college districts, develop a plan for the organization of 17 the entire state into community college districts, under which: 18 19 20 (i) The entire state is divided into community 21 college districts; 22 23 (ii) All territory within each proposed district 24 is contiguous;

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2 (iii) Each proposed district expands upon 3 districts established before July 1, 2008, and approved by 4 the commission under W.S. 21-18-202(d); 5 (iv) Each proposed district contains a community 6 7 college existing prior to this date and offering certificate and degree programs approved by the commission 8 9 under W.S. 21-18-202(d); 10 11 (v) The territory within each proposed district 12 into trustee residence is divided areas such that representation is provided to every portion of any county 13 14 within the proposed district and the total deviation in the population between the areas with the greatest and least 15 population does not, to the extent practicable, exceed ten 16 17 percent (10%); 18 19 (vi) To the extent practicable, consideration is 20 given to the per capita assessed valuation of the area 21 within the proposed district to the state as a whole;

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23 (vii) Consideration is also given to the 24 required number of mills a district must levy for the

1 general support and operation of the district to qualify

2 for state funding under W.S. 21-18-205(a)(ii), provided the

3 required levy shall not exceed the four (4) mills

4 authorized under W.S. 21-18-304(a)(vii).

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6 (b) The district organization plan developed under

7 subsection (a) of this section shall be presented to the

8 joint education interim committee and the joint

9 appropriations interim committee not later than September

10 1, 2007. Based upon the report, the joint education

11 interim committee shall develop recommendations together

12 with necessary enabling legislation in sufficient time for

13 consideration by the Wyoming legislature in the 2008 budget

14 session.

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16 **Section 3.** This act is effective immediately upon

17 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

18 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
