- 11 6-3-203. Cruelty to animals; penalties; limitation on
- 12 manner of destruction.

- 14 (e) Unless punishable under subsection (n) of this
- 15 section, a violation of this section is a misdemeanor

- 1 punishable by imprisonment for not more than six (6)
- 2 months, a fine of not more than seven hundred fifty dollars
- 3 (\$750.00), or both except that a subsequent offense or
- 4 aggravated cruelty to animals as defined by subsection (c)
- 5 of this section is a high misdemeanor felony punishable by
- 6 not more than one (1) year two (2) years imprisonment, a
- 7 fine of not more than five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00), or
- 8 both.

- 11 cruelty; penalty for interference with officer.

- 13 Any peace officer, municipal animal control officer or
- 14 agent or officer of the board may lawfully interfere to
- 15 prevent the perpetration of any act of cruelty upon any
- 16 animal in his presence. Any person who interferes with,
- 17 obstructs or resists any peace officer, municipal animal
- 18 control officer or officer or agent of the board in the
- 19 discharge of his duty shall be fined not less than two
- 20 hundred dollars (\$200.00) nor more than one thousand five
- 21 hundred dollars (\$1,500.00), or imprisoned not more than
- 22 one (1) year, or both.

4 Any peace officer, municipal animal control officer or 5 agent or officer of the board may take charge of any animal found abandoned, neglected or cruelly treated. He shall 6 7 give notice to the owner, if known, and may care and provide for the animal until the owner takes charge of the 8 9 The expenses of care and provision is a charge animal. 10 against the owner of the animal and collectible from the 11 owner by the board or by the local government employing the peace officer or municipal animal control officer taking 12 13 charge of the animal in a civil action. The board or local 14 government may detain the animals until the expense for food, shelter and care is paid and shall have a lien upon 15 16 the animals therefor.
