1 (i) Any dispatcher continuously employed by the

2 Wyoming highway patrol on or before July 1, 2002, who

3 continues to be employed in that position and is currently

4 enrolled as a law enforcement officer for purposes of W.S.

5 9-3-432, shall receive law enforcement service credit under

6 W.S. 9-3-432 for all prior service from the date of

7 employment through July 1, 2007;

9 (ii) Any dispatcher continuously employed by the Wyoming highway patrol before July 1, 2002, who continues 10 11 to be employed in that position and is not currently 12 enrolled as a law enforcement officer for purposes of W.S. 13 9-3-432, shall on or before July 1, 2007, elect to either enroll as an officer under W.S. 9-3-432 on or before July 14 15 1, 2007, or remain under the retirement program pursuant to W.S. 9-3-401 through 9-3-430. If an election is made 16 17 pursuant to this paragraph to enroll as an officer, the electing dispatcher shall receive law enforcement service 18 credit under W.S. 9-3-432 for all prior service from the 19 20 date of employment through July 1, 2007. Any highway 21 patrol dispatcher electing not to enroll as an officer 22 shall not receive any law enforcement service credit under

W.S. 9-3-432 as made available under this paragraph.
