

ENROLLED ACT NO. 128, HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

FIFTY-NINTH LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING
2007 GENERAL SESSION

AN ACT relating to child support; authorizing the department of family services to recover a federally mandated fee for specified child support enforcement services provided by the department; providing an appropriation; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 20-6-105 by creating a new subsection (c) is amended to read:

20-6-105. Eligibility for services; fees for services.

(c) The department shall, to comply with federal law, collect an annual fee from the obligee for child support enforcement services provided under paragraph (a)(ii) of this section. The department shall recover the fee from the obligee. The court may assess the fee to the obligor in any child support order.

Section 2. There is appropriated three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000.00), or as much thereof as necessary, from the general fund to the department of family services for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007 and ending June 30, 2008, to implement the purposes of this act. No part of this appropriation shall be expended without the prior approval of the chief information officer for any computer and software services and by the governor for all remaining expenditures.
