The governor may remove any 18 coordinator as provided in W.S. 9-1-202;-19 20 21 (iii) As part of its local homeland security 22 plan and in consultation with the office of homeland 23 security, prepare a plan of evacuation in the event of a 24 local disaster, which shall include provision for

1	evacuation notice to all residents, the transport of
2	persons with disabilities and the transport of service dogs
3	as defined in W.S. 35-13-205(a)(i). The evacuation plan
4	shall also provide for evacuation of pets with their owners
