Local homeland security plans.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to homeland security; amending requirements
2 for local homeland security plans; requiring local plans to
3 include evacuation provisions for residents and animals as
4 specified; and providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 19-13-108 is amended to read:

9

10 **19-13-108. Local programs; authorized; local homeland**
11 **security plan; coordinators; appointment and removal.**

13 (a) Each political subdivision of this state shall
14 establish a local homeland security program in accordance
15 with the state homeland security plan and program. Each

1 political subdivision through the homeland security program
2 ~~will cause to be prepared shall:~~

4 (i) Prepare a local homeland security plan which
5 will include actions essential to the recovery and
6 restoration of the economy by supply and resupply of
7 resources to meet urgent survival and military needs and to
8 provide for the ongoing management of resources available
9 to meet continuing survival and recovery needs; ~~Each local~~
10 ~~homeland security program shall~~

11

12 (ii) Have a coordinator appointed by the
13 governor upon the recommendation of the local jurisdiction.
14 The coordinator has direct responsibility for the
15 organization, administration and operation of the local
16 homeland security program subject to the direction and
17 control of the local jurisdiction under the general
18 direction of the governor. The governor may remove any
19 coordinator as provided in W.S. 9-1-202;

21 (iii) As part of its local homeland security
22 plan and in consultation with the office of homeland
23 security, prepare a plan of evacuation in the event of a
24 local disaster, which shall include provision for

1 evacuation notice to all residents, the transport of
2 persons with disabilities and the transport of service dogs
3 as defined in W.S. 35-13-205(a)(i). The evacuation plan
4 shall also provide for evacuation of pets with their owners
5 whenever such evacuations can be accomplished without
6 endangering human life.

7

8 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2007.
