1 AN ACT relating to retirement; excluding law enforcement  
2 dispatchers from law enforcement retirement and providing  
3 for participation in nonlaw enforcement retirement;  
4 specifying application; and providing for an effective  
5 date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-3-402(a)(xviii) is amended to read:

11 **9-3-402. Definitions.**

13 (a) As used in this article:

14

15 (xviii) "Law enforcement officer" or "officer"

16 means any member who is a county sheriff, deputy county

1 sheriff, municipal police officer, duly authorized  
2 investigator of the Wyoming livestock board meeting the  
3 specifications of W.S. 7-2-101(a)(iv)(E), investigator  
4 employed by the Wyoming state board of outfitters and  
5 professional guides meeting the specifications of W.S.  
6 7-2-101(a)(iv)(J), Wyoming correctional officer, probation  
7 and parole agent employed by the Wyoming department of  
8 corrections, Wyoming law enforcement academy instructor,  
9 University of Wyoming campus police officer, ~~or~~ or detention  
10 officer ~~or dispatcher~~ for law enforcement agencies;

12 **Section 2.** W.S. 9-3-402(a)(xviii), as amended under  
13 section 1 of this act, shall apply only to those  
14 dispatchers employed by law enforcement agencies on or  
15 after July 1, 2007, and shall not apply to any service  
16 credit earned by law enforcement dispatchers employed prior  
17 to July 1, 2007.

19 **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2007.
