- 15 violence and sexual assault advocate, interpreters,
- 16 translators and victim.

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2 (a) As used in this section:

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4 (vii) "Interpreter or translator" means a person

5 who facilitates dialogue between the advocate and the

6 victim who use different languages.

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- 8 (b) Except as provided by W.S. 14-3-210, a person
- 9 exempted from testifying under the provisions of W.S.
- 10 1-12-116 shall not be examined as a witness in any civil,
- 11 criminal, legislative or administrative proceeding
- 12 concerning the following communications and information:

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- 14 (iii) An interpreter or translator shall not
- 15 testify concerning a confidential communication made
- 16 between the victim and the advocate in the course of that
- 17 <u>relationship</u>, except the interpreter or translator may be
- 18 compelled to testify as provided in paragraph (b)(i):

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- 20 (A) About the accuracy of the translation,
- 21 if the accuracy of the translation is challenged.
