7	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:
8	
9	Section 1. W.S. 6-4-405(b) and by creating a new
10	subsection (d) is amended to read:
11	
12	6-4-405. Endangering children; controlled substances;
13	penalty.

15	(b) No person having the care or custody of a child
16	shall knowingly and willfully permit the child to remain in

1	a room, dwelling or vehicle where that person knows that
2	methamphetamine is <u>currently</u> possessed, stored or ingested.
3	
4	(d) For purposes of this section, "child" means any
5	person who has not yet reached the eighteenth anniversary
6	of his birth.
7	
8	Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2007.
