A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to the Wyoming Cosmetology Act; clarifying
- 2 requirements for independent contractors of cosmetology
- 3 salons and schools; authorizing investigations and
- 4 penalties for violations of the act; specifying that
- 5 practicing outside the scope of a license is a violation of
- 6 the act; authorizing the board of cosmetology to seek
- 7 injunctions to prevent violations of the act as specified;
- 8 and providing for an effective date.

10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

12 **Section 1.** W.S. 33-12-141 is created to read:

14 33-12-141. Action for injunction.

- 16 The board in its own name may bring an action for an
- 17 injunction, and courts of this state may enjoin any person

- 2 this section may be prosecuted by the attorney general's
- 3 office or by private counsel.

- 5 **Section 2.** W.S. 33-12-127 by creating a new
- 6 subsection (c) and by renumbering (c) as (d) and (d) as
- 7 (f), 33-12-135(a)(intro) and by creating a new paragraph
- 8 (x) and 33-12-138(a)(i) are amended to read:

- 10 33-12-127. Licenses required; failure to comply;

- 13 (c) A licensee who is not an employee of a salon or
- 14 school shall not engage in the practice of or as an
- 15 instructor of cosmetology, manicuring/nail technology,

- 17 board a certificate to practice as an independent

1 hair stylist, instructor, owner of the salon or owner of 2 the school; 3 4 (ii) State the licensing and expiration dates; 5 and 6 7 (iii) Be displayed at all times in a conspicuous place in the principal office, place of business or 8 9 employment of the licensee. 10 11 (d)(f) Any person who practices or teaches cosmetology, manicuring or nail technology, esthetics or 12 hair styling for compensation, or who carries on any 13 14 business, practice or operation governed by this act, without the applicable license when a license is required, 15 16 is quilty of a misdemeanor punishable, upon conviction, by 17 a fine of not more than seven hundred fifty dollars 18 (\$750.00). 19 20 33-12-135. Powers to revoke, refuse, suspend, refuse 21 to renew licenses; grounds; procedures. 22 The board, upon a written sworn complaint or upon 23 24 its own motion, may investigate the actions of any licensee
