## A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to the education loan repayment program;
- 2 establishing an education loan repayment program for
- 3 students with baccalaureate degrees who pursue the
- 4 accelerated program for baccalaureate degrees in nursing;
- 5 specifying requirements; providing for loan forgiveness as
- 6 specified; requiring reports; providing an appropriation;
- 7 and providing for an effective date.

9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

10

11 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-17-118 is created to read:

12

- 13 21-17-118. Accelerated baccalaureate degree in
- 14 nursing for students with other baccalaureate degrees;
- 15 contracts with students; repayment of funds expended;
- 16 deposit of repayments.

2 (a) Students desiring to participate in the

3 university's accelerated program leading to a baccalaureate

4 degree in nursing may avail themselves of the financial aid

5 opportunities under this section subject to the following:

6

7 (i) Before enrolling in the accelerated

8 baccalaureate in nursing degree program, the student shall

9 be approved by the president of the university acting with

10 the advice of the state board of nursing;

11

12 (ii) No student shall be approved by the

13 president unless the student has obtained a baccalaureate

14 degree in a discipline other than nursing;

15

16 (iii) Preference for financial aid under this

17 section shall be given to applicants who individually or

18 through their spouse meet the requirements of W.S.

19 21-17-105(d).

20

21 (b) In addition to the requirements of subsection

22 (a), before granting any financial aid under this section

23 the board of trustees shall obtain an agreement from each

24 student whereby the student authorizes the state of Wyoming

1 to pay not more than twenty-five thousand dollars

2 (\$25,000.00) for financial aid while the student is

3 enrolled in the accelerated nursing degree program. The

4 student shall agree either to:

5

6 (i) Actively engage in work as a nurse in

7 Wyoming for two (2) years, as the board of trustees

8 requires. Qualified work shall be granted on a proportional

9 basis; or

10

11 (ii) Repay all amounts expended by the state of

12 Wyoming under this subsection on the student's education,

13 together with interest which shall begin accruing upon the

14 student's graduation, upon terms specified by the board of

15 trustees. However, interest shall begin to accrue if the

16 board finds that the student has withdrawn from the degree

17 program or is otherwise not making satisfactory progress

18 toward completion of the degree program. Money expended

19 under this subsection shall accrue at an annual interest

20 rate equal to that charged for federal Stafford loans at

21 the time interest begins to accrue, which rate shall be

22 adjusted annually to match the federal Stafford loan rate.

23 In no event shall the interest rate be greater than eight

3

24 percent (8%).

1

2 (c) Upon recommendation of the president of the 3 university, the board of trustees may relieve a student of 4 the obligation to repay amounts expended under subsection 5 (b) of this section, in whole or in part, upon a finding that the monies cannot be collected. The university shall 6 annually report the number of students relieved from 7 repayment under this paragraph to the joint labor, health 8 9 and social services interim committee not later than

October 1.

12 (d) Loan repayment options under this section may be
13 deferred for a period not to exceed five (5) years while a
14 loan recipient is serving on full-time active duty with any
15 branch of the military services of the United States.

16

17 (e) Any recipient of a loan under this section who 18 fails:

19

20 (i) To complete the program for which the loan
21 was provided shall commence cash repayment of the loan no
22 later than forty-five (45) days after the recipient leaves
23 the academic program;

24

1 (ii) To obtain employment in the targeted

2 occupation for which the person received the education

3 within ninety (90) days after successfully obtaining the

4 appropriate licensure, shall commence cash repayment of the

5 loan within one hundred twenty (120) days after

6 successfully obtaining the appropriate licensure; or

7

8 (iii) To obtain the appropriate certification

9 within one hundred eighty (180) days after completion of

10 the program shall commence cash repayment of the loan.

11

12 (f) Any amounts paid by students in accordance with

the contractual arrangements authorized under this section

14 shall be deposited into a special fund designated as the

15 accelerated baccalaureate degree in nursing student fund,

16 maintained and separately accounted for by the University

17 of Wyoming, which fund shall be used solely for payments to

18 students under subsection (b) of this section. On or before

19 October 1 of each year, the university shall submit a

20 report to the joint labor, health and social services

21 interim committee on expenditures from the fund during the

22 prior fiscal year.

There is appropriated from the general 1 Section 2.

2 fund to the University of Wyoming four hundred twenty-five

3 thousand dollars (\$425,000.00). Three hundred seventy-five

4 thousand dollars (\$375,000.00) shall be used to provide

5 loans to students under this act and no more than fifty

thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) shall be used to implement 6

7 the remaining provisions of this act. Those funds necessary

to support students who began the program prior to June 30, 8

9 2008 shall not revert to the general fund until June 30,

10 2010. Funds appropriated under this section shall be

11 included in the university's 167 medical education budget

12 and not in the block grant.

13

14 Section 3. This act is effective immediately upon

completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law 15

as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the 16

17 Constitution.
