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2 license (d) If a driver's with limited driving 3 privileges is granted pursuant to W.S. 31-7-105(f), the fee 4 shall be twenty five dollars (\$25.00) forty-five dollars 5 (\$45.00). 6 7 (e) Notwithstanding W.S. 31-7-131(c), if a driver's license is reinstated after a period of suspension or 8 9 revocation, the fee for the reinstatement shall be fifty dollars (\$50.00) eighty-five dollars (\$85.00) unless the 10 final decision by the hearing examiner, or a court reverses 11 12 the action taken by the department. If a driver's license 13 is reinstated after suspension for nonpayment of child 14 support pursuant to W.S. 20-6-111 or 20-6-112, the fee for reinstatement shall be not more than five dollars (\$5.00). 15 If a driver's license is reinstated after suspension for 16 17 driving while under the influence under W.S. 31-7-128(b), 18 the fee for reinstatement shall be one hundred twenty-five 19 dollars (\$125.00).

Every applicant for an identification card shall pay ten 23

24 dollars (\$10.00) twenty dollars (\$20.00) to the department.

1 The state treasurer shall credit identification card fees 2 to the highway fund.

4 39-14-801. Severance tax distributions; distribution 5 account created; formula.

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- 7 (d) After making distributions under subsections (b)
- 8 and (c) of this section, distributions under subsection (e)
- 9 of this section shall be made from the severance tax
- 10 distribution account. The amount of distributions under
- 11 subsection (e) of this section shall not exceed one hundred
- 12 fifty-five million dollars (\$155,000,000.00) in any fiscal
- 13 year. To the extent that distributions under subsection (e)
- 14 of this section would exceed that amount in any fiscal
- 15 year, the excess shall be credited:

- 17 (i) One third (1/3) Thirty-one and eighty-nine
- 18 hundredths percent (31.89%) to the general fund; and
