

## HOUSE BILL NO. HB0273

Driver's license-selective service.

Sponsored by: Representative(s) Esquibel, F.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; providing that qualified  
2 applicants be registered with the selective service system  
3 in order to receive a driver's license or an identification  
4 card; providing that qualified applicants not registered be  
5 ineligible to receive a license or identification card; and  
6 providing for an effective date.

8 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9

10 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-7-108(b) by creating a new  
11 paragraph (ix), 31-7-111 by creating new subsections (g)  
12 through (m), 31-8-101 by creating new subsections (c)  
13 through (g) and 31-8-103 by creating a new subsection (d)  
14 are amended to read:

15

16 **31-7-108. Persons not to be licensed; investigation**  
17 **by the division.**

1

2 (b) The division shall not issue or renew any  
3 driver's license to any person:

4

5 (ix) Who is not in compliance with W.S.  
6 31-7-111(g) through (m).

7

8 **31-7-111. Application for license or permit**  
9 **generally.**

10

11 (g) Qualified applicants for a motor vehicle driver's  
12 license pursuant to this section or an instruction and  
13 temporary permit shall be registered with the United States  
14 selective service system in compliance with title 50 U.S.C.  
15 appendix § 453, as amended.

16

17 (h) Every qualified applicant identified in  
18 subsection (g) of this section shall be required to  
19 authorize the division to:

20

21 (i) Collect the necessary personal information  
22 required for registering the qualified applicant with the  
23 United States selective service system; and

24

1           (ii) Electronically transmit the information to  
2 the selective service system pursuant to subsection (k) of  
3 this section for purposes of registering the qualified  
4 applicant with the selective service system.

5  
6           (j) The division shall notify all qualified  
7 applicants identified in subsection (g) of this section  
8 that by submitting an application, the qualified applicant  
9 is consenting to registration with the selective service  
10 system, if so required by federal law.

11  
12           (k) The division shall collect from a qualified  
13 applicant the necessary personal information required for  
14 registering the qualified applicant with the United States  
15 selective service system. The division shall transmit the  
16 necessary personal information of the qualified applicant  
17 in an electronic format to the selective service system to  
18 register the qualified applicant.

19  
20           (m) For purposes of this section, "qualified  
21 applicant" means male United States citizens and male  
22 immigrants at least eighteen (18) years of age but less  
23 than twenty-six (26) years of age.

1           **31-8-101. Issuance to residents by department;**  
2 **restrictions.**

3

4           (c) Qualified applicants for an identification card  
5 shall be registered with the United States selective  
6 service system in compliance with title 50 U.S.C. appendix  
7 § 453, as amended.

8

9           (d) Every qualified applicant identified in  
10 subsection (g) of this section shall be required to  
11 authorize the department of transportation to:

12

13           (i) Collect the necessary personal information  
14 required for registering the qualified applicant with the  
15 United States selective service system; and

16

17           (ii) Electronically transmit the information to  
18 the selective service system pursuant to subsection (f) of  
19 this section for purposes of registering the qualified  
20 applicant with the selective service system.

21

22           (e) The department of transportation shall notify all  
23 qualified applicants identified in subsection (c) of this  
24 section that by submitting an application, the qualified is

1 consenting to registration with the selective service  
2 system, if so required by federal law.

3  
4 (f) The department of transportation shall collect  
5 from a qualified applicant the necessary personal  
6 information required for registering the qualified  
7 applicant with the United States selective service system.  
8 The department of transportation shall transmit the  
9 necessary personal information of the qualified applicant  
10 in an electronic format to the selective service system to  
11 register the qualified applicant.

12  
13 (g) For purposes of this section, "qualified  
14 applicant" means male United States citizens and male  
15 immigrants at least eighteen (18) years of age but less  
16 than twenty-six (26) years of age.

17  
18 **31-8-103. Expiration; records; new cards.**

19  
20 (d) The department of transportation shall not issue  
21 an identification card under this section to a qualified  
22 applicant, as defined by W.S. 31-8-101(g), unless the  
23 applicant complies with W.S. 31-8-101(c) through (g).

1       **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2007.
