Game and fish-pioneer licenses.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to game and fish; providing for free and  
2 reduced price resident turkey licenses for certain long  
3 term residents as specified; and providing for an effective  
4 date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 23-1-705(e)(i) and (ii) is amended to  
9 read:

10

11 **23-1-705. Complimentary licenses; one-shot antelope**  
12 **hunt licenses; gunpowder and buckskin hunt licenses;**  
13 **gratuitous licenses.**

15 (e) The department shall issue:

16

1           (i) For a fee of two dollars (\$2.00) a resident  
2 deer, ~~or~~ antelope or turkey license and for a fee of five  
3 dollars (\$5.00) an elk license to any resident who was born  
4 on or before January 1, 1930, and who has continuously  
5 resided in Wyoming for at least the forty (40) years  
6 immediately preceding application for the license; and

7  
8           (ii) For a fee established by rule of the  
9 commission a resident deer, antelope, turkey or elk license  
10 to any resident who was born after January 1, 1930, is at  
11 least seventy (70) years of age prior to the issuance of  
12 the license and has continuously resided in Wyoming for at  
13 least fifty (50) years immediately preceding application  
14 for the license. The fee established for a license under  
15 this paragraph shall be not more than sixty-five percent  
16 (65%) nor less than sixty percent (60%) of the resident fee  
17 specified in W.S. 23-2-101 for the particular species;

19           **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2007.
