AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; providing for permitted length for saddlemount combinations; providing conforming amendments; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 31-5-1009, 31-18-802(a)(iv)(intro) and 31-18-803(a)(ii) are amended to read:

31-5-1009. Prohibition of triple trailers.

Except for the provisions of W.S. 31-18-808, after July 1, $\frac{1993}{100}$, and $\frac{31-18-803}{100}$ no vehicle combination composed of more than three (3) single vehicles shall operate by special permit, test permit, or otherwise on the highways of this state.

31-18-802. General requirements.

- (a) All vehicles operated on the highways of this state shall comply with the following:
- (iv) Length all highways, except as provided in 31-18-803(a):

31-18-803. Conditions for operating vehicles transporting other vehicles.

- (a) Vehicles used for transporting other vehicles may be operated singly, or in combinations by the towbar, saddlemount or full-mount methods, subject to the following terms and conditions:
- (ii) Notwithstanding W.S. 31-5-1009 and 31-18-802 (a) (iv), no more than three (3) saddlemounts may

be used in any combination except additional vehicles may be transported when safely loaded upon the frame of a vehicle in a properly assembled saddlemount combination and the overall length of the saddlemount combination does not exceed ninety-seven (97) feet;

Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2007.
